

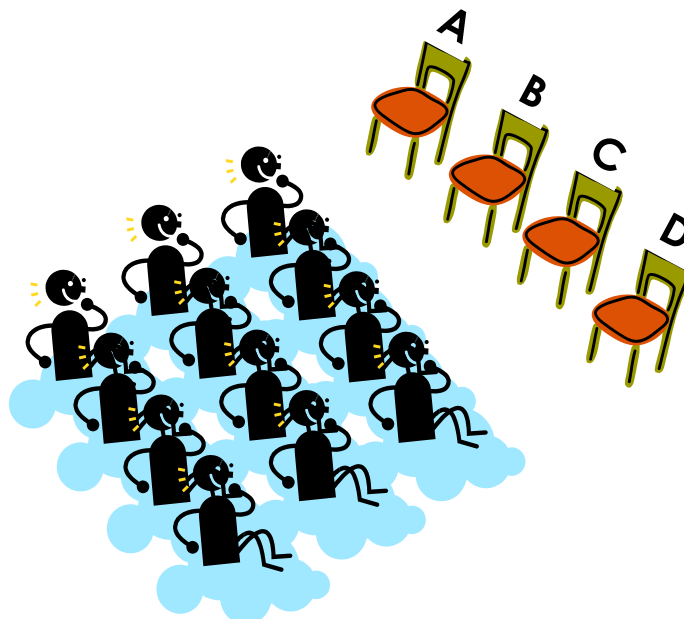
## CHRISTMAS TRIVIA CHAIRS

You need: 4 chairs placed to face the group labelled A,B,C and D  
 Players arranged in rows of 4 facing the chairs  
 Christmas trivia questions

Object: to have a good laugh



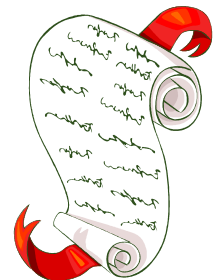
- ◇ Arrange the furniture and children.
- ◇ Explain that each row will have a turn at choosing and sitting on a chair. When their turn is finished they go and sit at the back of the group in their row of 4.
- ◇ First row choose a chair, sits and faces the audience.
- ◇ Teacher reads out the trivia question. Teacher then walks behind each chair reading out the A then B, then C and D choices behind corresponding chair. Hopefully the audience are in fits of laughter with some of the very unlikely answers.
- ◇ Teacher returns to chair A, rereads trivia question and answer A. Audience then 'vote' if it is the correct answer. Repeat for B,C and D.
- ◇ Teacher verifies the correct trivia answer. The 'winning' player who is sitting in the correct chair can receive a Christmas stamp or sticker.
